

Coronavirus Statement from Old Cedar Campground

Campers: Sadly, some people are not following the State mandated no visitor policy. We must enforce a no visitor policy. Social Distancing is now in effect until April 30, 2020. Visitors put us at risk of not being able to re-open when Social Distancing restrictions are finally lifted. This means absolutely no visitors to the campground. You may not stop in, drop off or pick up items, etc. Violators will lose all camping privileges for 2020. No exceptions. No refunds. This includes seasonal campers. The neighbors are on the lookout and will report your visits to management. Thank you for your immediate cooperation. *(Updated 03/29/2020)*

To Our Loyal Camping Families:

First and foremost, we hope you and your families are well, healthy and safe. For the safety of our staff and our camping families during this COVID-19 pandemic, please review the following:

1. We have reviewed the CDC guidelines with our staff and we are sanitizing for safety.
2. Our office will remain closed to visitors; employees only at this time. We will not be selling supplies of any kind, including ice. Please stock up before you arrive to camp.
3. Our office staff is still working, but remotely. You can reach them by calling: 856-358-4881.
4. Our goal is to be open April 17, 2020 as scheduled, but this is subject to change.
5. Based on CDC, local, state and federal guidelines, there will be modifications to our operations. We will update as conditions change; this situation is fluid.
6. Please be patient as we navigate these uncharted waters together. We are DILIGENTLY working through spring maintenance programs.
7. **The game room, office, pavilion, children's playground and miniature golf areas will remain closed until further notice.**
8. **The bath houses will remain closed.**
9. **Only self-contained RVs, Travel Trailers, and Motor homes may be permitted to camp at this time. If you do not have a working refrigerator, working sink, toilet and bathing area in your camper, you may not camp at this time. Please DO NOT reserve a campsite if you are not self-contained. Please, do not force us to turn you away. The fees you paid will not be refunded.**
10. **If you are sick, your family with whom you live are sick, or are caring for a person who is sick, please do not camp.**

11. If you appear sick, we reserve the right to ask you to return home. **Your immediate compliance is required.**

12. **Social Distancing is in effect. No more than 6 people per campsite reservation.**

- Please do not plan large social events for your camping stay.
- No additional visitors at this time. Only those people listed on your reservation may join you at camp.
- No gatherings at campfires.
- Other campers are not permitted on your campsite. Smiles and waves across campsites are permitted.
